Dear Judge Woodruff:

On behalf of The Empire District Electric Company, I am providing herewith to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) for filing, in electronic form, certain tariff sheets consisting of revised rate schedules which are designed to comply with the Commission’s *Amended Report and Order*, issued July 23, 2020, effective August 2, 2020, as clarified, and the Commission’s *Order Directing the Filing of Compliance Tariffs* issued and effective August 12, 2020, in Case No. ER-2019-0374.

To begin the general rate case, the tariff sheets submitted by the Company were all part of “Schedule of Rates for Electricity” designated P.S.C. No. 5. The compliance tariff sheets, however, are all part of “Schedule of Rates for Electricity” designated P.S.C. No. 6. All of these are labeled as new schedules and bear a date of issue of August 17, 2020, and an effective date thirty days thereafter (September 16, 2020). The complete tariff book is being submitted to reflect the addition of the “Liberty” fictitious name for The Empire District Electric Company. Redlined changes are being provided to the parties, as well as a revenue allocation and rate design workpaper.
