## ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST FOR A STAY IN PROCEEDINGS AND DIRECTING FILING

On March 13, 2009, JACOR Contracting, Inc. ("JACOR"), NuVox Communications of Missouri, Inc. ("NuVox") and Southwestern Bell Communications Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") jointly filed a request seeking a stay of the current proceedings, because JACOR and NuVox have tentatively agreed to a resolution of JACOR's claims. The parties represent that the agreement will ultimately result in JACOR dismissing its claims against NuVox and AT&T Missouri with prejudice. The parties request a stay of 30 days complete the settlement agreement. The Commission finds the joint request for a stay reasonable and shall grant it. The Commission shall further direct JACOR to file a notice of dismissal once the settlement agreement is complete or a status report at the completion of the stay.
