ORDER GRANTING WAIVERS

On August 28, 2008, House Bill 1779 became effective, modifying §392.420 RSMo 2000, so that it now provides, in pertinent part:

[F]or all existing alternative local exchange telecommunications companies, the commission shall waive, at a minimum, the application and enforcement of its quality of service and billing standards rules, as well as the provisions of subsection 2 of section 392.210, subsection 1 of section 392.240, and sections 392.270, 392.280, 392.290, 392.300, 392.310, 392.320, 392.330, and 392.340.

On December 10, 2008, Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation (the Company) filed a request with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") that Commission waive certain rules and statutory provisions pursuant to RSMo Section 392.420.

On January 9, 2009, the Commission Staff submitted its memorandum concerning the request. It noted that:

1. The Company is alternative local exchange telecommunications companies as that term is used in Section 392.420.

2. The Company is currently compliant in obligations relating to Commission assessment, Missouri Universal Service Fund, Relay Missouri, and the submission of an annual report.

The waivers requested by the Company are:

4 CSR 240-3.550 (4) and (5)(A) Held order records and quality of service reports
4 CSR 240-32.060 Engineering and maintenance
4 CSR 240-32.070 Quality of Service
4 CSR 240-32.080 Service objectives and surveillance levels
4 CSR 240-33.040(1) through (3) and (5) through (10) Billing and payment standards
4 CSR 240-33.045 Clear identification and placement of charges on bills
4 CSR 240-33.080 (1) Toll-free number for billing disputes on bills
4 CSR 240-33.130 (1), (4) and (5) Operator service billing requirements
392.300.1 Transfer of property and ownership of stock

The Staff recommends that the Commission grant the Company's requested waivers and direct the Companies to list these waivers in the Company's tariffs.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Company's Request for Waiver of the above-listed provisions is granted.
2. The Company is directed to list the granted waivers in its tariffs no later than February 14, 2009.
3. This order is effective upon issuance, after which this case may be closed.
