Thank you for submitting your 2006 Annual Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission. As a result of my review I have that your submission is not in compliance with Chapter 3 of 4 CSR 240 for Nonpublic Treatment of the Annual Report. The following items are required for a highly confidential submission:

1a. Provide both a fully completed version to be kept under seal and a redacted public version that clearly informs the reader that the redacted information has been submitted under seal. The cover of each version must clearly identify whether it is the public or the non-public version. Each page of each version of the report containing non-public information should be clearly identified as containing such information.

1b. Submit both versions of the annual report with a cover letter stating that the utility is designating some or all of the information in its annual report as confidential information, including the name, phone number and e-mail address (if available) of the person responsible for addressing questions regarding the confidential portions of the annual report.

1c. Prominently attach a detailed affidavit to both versions that identifies the specific types of information to be kept under seal, provides a reason why the specific information should be a closed record, and stating that none of the requested information is available to the public in any format.

These guidelines for submitting a confidential annual report were outlined in the cover page of the report form that was mailed to you. For your convenience, I have attached a copy of that cover letter. If you choose to file as a public report, simply check the public box on the cover of the report.

In addition, I have also identified the following item(s) for correction:

2. Your response to page 1, question 4, part b, was omitted. The latest case number is **XA-2006-0204**. Please include this information on any future submissions.
3. The company's name incorrectly listed. Our records indicate the company's current certificated name is AmeriVon LLC. Until a Commission approved name change is complete, this is the name that will remain on file and active. The report must include the current name on each line requesting the company's name.

A response for these items is required in order to accept your annual report as complete and prevent it from being filed as public. Pending your response I have provided the Commission's Data Center with a copy of this email to be filed in conjunction with your annual report.

Your prompt attention to resolving this matter will be appreciated. The Missouri Public Service Commission's rules within chapter 3 of 4 CSR 240 state that a utility company that receives a notice that deficiencies exist in the information provided in the annual report shall respond to that notice within 20 days or the utility company

is subject to a penalty of \$100 for each day that it is late in filing its response to the deficiency.
