**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INDICATE WHEN IT CAN FILE A  
RECOMMENDATION**

On April 28, 2005, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application for authority to modify certain provisions of bonds that were authorized by previous Commission actions. The Commission will need to have a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the application. So that it may be aware of progress in this case, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a pleading indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall, no later than May 18, 2005, file a pleading advising the Commission when Staff will be able to file its recommendation regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's application.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2005.
