ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING STATING WHEN IT WILL FILE A RECOMMENDATION IN THIS CASE

On February 18, 2011, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed an application seeking authority to issue up to \$500,000,000 of new long-term indebtedness.¹ The Commission will need a recommendation from its Staff before acting on Ameren Missouri’s application. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation in this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than March 3, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.
2. Any other party that wishes to respond to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri’s application shall do so no later than March 3, 2011.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
