**NOTICE OF COMPLAINT**

On May 16, 2005, Christian R. Atlakson filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Kansas City Power & Light. A copy of the complaint is enclosed. Under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, KCPL has 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer or to file notification that the complaint has been satisfied. Since this notice is being issued on May 18, KCPL's response will be due by June 17.

In the alternative, KCPL may file a written request that the complaint be referred to a neutral third-party mediator for voluntary mediation of the complaint. Upon receipt of a request for mediation, the 30-day time period will be tolled while the Commission ascertains whether the complainant is also willing to submit to voluntary mediation. If the complainant agrees to mediation, the time period within which an answer is due will be suspended pending the resolution of the mediation process. Additional information regarding the mediation process is enclosed.

If the complainant declines the opportunity to seek mediation, KCPL will be notified in writing that the tolling has ceased and will also be notified of the date by which an answer or notice of satisfaction must be filed. That period will usually be the remainder of the original 30-day period.

All pleadings (the answer, the notice of satisfaction of complaint, or request for mediation) must be mailed to:
