On July 12, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed a Motion to file its answer out of time. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, parties shall not be allowed more than ten days to respond to pleadings. Therefore, if Tony Walker objects, the Commission will require Mr. Walker to respond to KCPL's motion within ten days from the effective date of this order. In his response, Mr. Walker must state the reasons for his objection. If, however, Mr. Walker does not object to the Commission accepting KCPL's late-filed answer, he need not file a response.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. If Tony Walker objects to Kansas City Power & Light Company's motion to file its answer out of time, then he shall file such objection no later than July 24, 2006.
