On March 25, 2016, Towner Communications, LLC filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol ("IVoIP") service with the Missouri Public Service Commission indicating its intention to offer and provide IVoIP services in the State of Missouri.

The application filed with the Commission was not sufficient in that the application was not signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(2). In addition, the application filed with the Commission was not sufficient in that the attached affidavit failed to identify the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide IVoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo.

On April 5, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiencies by April 15, 2016. No response was filed. Thus, the application will be rejected by the Commission. Towner may file a new application in a new file if it chooses to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application filed by Towner Communications, LLC on March 25, 2016,
- is rejected.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
 - 3. This file may be closed.
