On November 13, 2013, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued a report and order effective December 13, 2013, regarding Charles Harter's complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On November 15, 2013, Mr. Harter filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, Mr. Harter has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Charles Harter's Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
