## ORDER REGARDING RE-FILING AND SUPPLEMENTING COMPLAINT

The Missouri Public Service Commission is taking official notice of the filings in Craig Mershon's earlier action, waiving the use of any special form for supplementing the complaint, and setting a time for filing that supplement.
