ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

The Commission previously issued a Report and Order finding Craig Mershon failed to prove Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") violated any statute, regulation, tariff or Commission order. Mr. Mershon timely filed what the Commission considered an application for rehearing. On June 2nd, Ameren Missouri filed its response to Mr. Mershon's application. Although the Commission issued an order granting Mr. Mershon's request for additional time, Mr. Mershon failed to file a reply by the June 18th deadline.¹

Section 386.500, RSMo 2000, authorizes the Commission to grant an application for rehearing if in its judgment, "sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Mr. Mershon fails to offer any substantive arguments. The Commission finds that Mr. Mershon failed to establish sufficient reason to grant his application for rehearing. The Commission will therefore deny the request.

1. The application for rehearing filed by Complainant Craig Mershon is denied.
