**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT
WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

Issue Date: April 29, 2015

Effective Date: May 29, 2015

Ullesseyo Whitehorn (Complainant) filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri alleging the company improperly billed her for a tenant's debt. The Commission set a prehearing conference¹ and Complainant failed to appear. The Commission then set a second prehearing conference² and Complainant again failed to appear.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3), a party may be dismissed from a case for failure to appear at a prehearing conference. Complainant has twice failed to appear for prehearing conferences. The Commission will therefore dismiss this complaint. Because this complaint is not being dismissed on the merits of the complaint, but rather on procedural grounds, Complainant may refile the complaint; in which case it will be assigned a different case number.
