a. The filing of a list of undisputed facts and a list of disputed issues of fact. Any disputed issue of fact listed shall be accompanied by a list of witnesses to testify on such issue; a proposed sequence for all witnesses; and a proposed sequence of cross-examination.

b. An evidentiary hearing, oral argument, or both, on jurisdiction. That date shall be not more than 30 days after the date of the conference.

c. Such other events as the parties deem helpful.

4. The room designated for the conference meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act and any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the hearing shall alert the Public Service Commission before the hearing by calling the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711.
