ORDER RESCHEDULING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

The Commission is granting the *Motion to Reschedule Procedural Conference*¹ filed by Midwest Energy Consumers Group, Inc.; cancelling the current setting for that conference, and re-setting the conference to convene at the same time as the conference scheduled, by separate order issued this day, in File No. EC-2017-0107.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural conference set for November 15, 2016 is cancelled.
2. On November 22, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, MO 65201, the Commission will convene the conference described in the body of this order. The Commission will convene the conference on the record and will go off the record for the parties to discuss procedural and substantive matters yet to be resolved. Any party, and any person who has filed an application for intervention, shall attend the conference.


3. No later than November 29, 2016, Staff shall file on behalf of all parties the schedule described in the body of this order (“schedule”). The schedule shall include proposed dates for:

- a. The filing of a list of undisputed facts and a list of disputed issues of fact. Any disputed issue of fact listed shall be accompanied by a list of witnesses to testify on such issue; a proposed sequence for all witnesses; and a proposed sequence of cross-examination.
- b. An evidentiary hearing, oral argument, or both, on jurisdiction. That date shall be not more than 30 days after the date of the conference.
- c. Such other events as the parties deem helpful.

4. The room designated for the conference meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act and any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the hearing shall alert the Public Service Commission before the hearing by calling the Commission’s Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
