AFFIDAVIT

- The filing requirements in 4 CSR 240-3, Filing and Reporting Requirements (Chapter 3), which became effective on April 30, 2003, specify that certain information associated with power plant production and information concerning purchases and sales with other providers shall be furnished monthly. It also specifies the circumstances that require the reporting of incidents at power plants.
- 2. Proposed changes in the rule are necessary to provide information on a timely basis in order to assist in the determination by the Commission of just and reasonable electric rates. The present reporting requirements would be broadened to provide more complete information, including an as-burned report for each generating unit and net system input data.
- In addition, the proposed rule would increase the minimum reportable loss from property damage at power plants in order to limit the reporting to the more significant events.

4. Present rules require reporting only of incidents that occur at power plants.

New reporting requirements of electric utilities and electric cooperatives of any accident involving an employee or other person, resulting from contact with its energized electrical supply facilities, would provide notice for the Commission or its Staff to initiate an investigation for code compliance in a timely fashion.
