MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

COMES NOW **BullsEye Telecom, Inc.** (“BullsEye” or “Applicant”), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(21), and moves for leave to amend its application in the above-referenced matter. In support thereof, Applicant submits the following:


1. BullsEye filed its application for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in portions of the State of Missouri and for competitive classification on September 25, 2002.
2. In its application, BullsEye sought to provide resold basic local telecommunication services in portions of the State of Missouri in the exchanges of GTE Midwest Incorporated d/b/a Verizon Midwest (“Verizon”).
3. BullsEye now notes that Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel has purchased the exchanges previously held by Verizon. Therefore, BullsEye requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission review its initial application replacing all references therein of Verizon with Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel and that it be granted the authority to provide competitive facilities-based and resold basic local exchange services to residential and business customers throughout the exchanges served by Spectra

Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel, as well as, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Sprint of Missouri as requested in its initial application.

WHEREFORE, BullsEye Telecom, Inc. requests that it be granted leave to amend its application in the particulars set forth above and to provide facilities-based and resold basic local telecommunication services in portions of the State of Missouri and the exchanges of Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel, as well as, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Sprint of Missouri.
