ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER

On April 29, 2005, Matrix Telecom, Inc., filed an Application for Certificate of Service Authority and for Competitive Classification. On May 11, 2005, Matrix filed an amendment to its application. With the amendment, Matrix filed certain financial information as Exhibit A and a Motion for Protective Order. Under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.085, Matrix requests a protective order with respect to the financial information filed as Exhibit A. Matrix states that its financial information is not available to the public and that disclosure of the income statements and balance sheets would be extremely detrimental if made public. Matrix further states that the financial information contained in Exhibit A cannot be found in any format in any other public document.

Upon review of Matrix's motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and that the request for a protective order is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information and the issuance of protective orders has helped to minimize disputes in past cases. Therefore, a protective order should be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion for Protective Order filed by Matrix Telecom, Inc., shall be granted and the protective order attached to this order (Attachment A) is adopted.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 16, 2005.
