## ORDER TO SHOW COMPLIANCE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing Broadvox-CLEC, LLC, (“Broadvox”) to show compliance with Commission regulations as follows.

Broadvox filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunication services (“application”). As to that application, on May 27, 2009, the Commission’s staff filed its recommendation. The recommendation states that the application does not comply with the following provision:

In addition to the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.060(1), applications for a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications services, whether interexchange, local exchange or basic local exchange, shall include:

(D) If the application is for basic local exchange service authority, the application shall also include the following:

1. . . .

B. Applicant shall submit on a pro forma basis, at least twelve (12) months of financial statements comprised of a balance sheet and an income statement. [<sup>1</sup>]

That provision is part of the Commission's regulation titled "Filing Requirements for Telecommunications Company Applications for Certificates of Service Authority to Provide Telecommunications Services, Whether Interexchange, Local Exchange or Basic Local Exchange."

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than June 11, 2009, Broadvox-CLEC, LLC, shall show that it has complied with 4 CSR 240-3.510(1).
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
