

**APPLICATION OF
BANDWIDTH.COM, CLEC, LLC**

I. INTRODUCTION

Comes now Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC (“Bandwidth.com” or “Applicant”), by its undersigned counsel, and hereby files this verified application pursuant to 4 CSR 24-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.510, and respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issue an order that (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Authority to provide resold and facilities-based basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri and facilities-based and resold interexchange telecommunications service throughout the State of Missouri, (b) grants competitive status to Applicant and (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo 2000.¹

The State of Missouri has adopted a policy of allowing competition in the local and long distance telecommunications markets, recognizing that it is in the public interest to develop effective competition to ensure that all consumers will have access to high quality, low cost, and

innovative telecommunications services. The Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 also seeks to promote competition and reduce regulation in order to secure lower prices and higher quality telecommunications services for American consumers. Both goals will be promoted by granting this Application.

The Applicant submits the following information in support of its request.

II. APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

A. Description of the Applicant

1. Applicant's legal name is Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC d/b/a Bandwidth.com.

B. Qualifications

6. Bandwidth.com is a Delaware LLC formed on January 9, 2007. A copy of its incorporation documents are attached hereto as Exhibit A. Bandwidth.com's authority to transact business as a foreign corporation in Missouri is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

7. Bandwidth.com is extremely well qualified to provide telecommunications services in Missouri. Bandwidth.com currently is authorized to provide telecommunications services in California, Florida, Illinois, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Texas. It has applications pending in Virginia and Georgia. Bandwidth.com has not been denied requested certification in any jurisdiction, nor has any permit, license, or certificate been revoked by any authority.

8. Bandwidth.com will depend on its parent company, Bandwidth.com, Inc. for financial support in providing services in Missouri. Financial information demonstrating Bandwidth.com, Inc.'s financial qualifications is provided in its most recent financial documents attached hereto as Exhibit C. As shown in the attached information, Bandwidth.com is financially qualified to operate within the State of Missouri.

9. Bandwidth.com is technically and managerially qualified to provide competitive local exchange and interexchange services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1), RSMo. Bandwidth.com's Missouri operations will be directed by its existing corporate management, technical and operations staffs who are responsible for the interexchange and local exchange operations in other states. A description of the background of Applicant's key personnel, which demonstrates the extensive managerial experience of Bandwidth.com's management team, is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

10. Applicant in the past three (3) years has not been a party to any regulatory proceedings.

Description of Services

11. Bandwidth.com seeks authority to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange throughout all exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Sprint, CenturyTel of Missouri and Spectra Communications and interexchange telecommunications services to and from all points in the State of Missouri. The specific exchanges within which Bandwidth.com proposes to offer service are listed in the incumbent local exchange carrier's ("ILEC") respective local exchange tariffs. Therefore, Bandwidth.com seeks only regional authority with respect to its basic local offerings, based upon the exchange footprint of the ILEC's just referenced, but seeks statewide authority for its interexchange service. Bandwidth.com may seek authority to provide basic local service in other areas of the State in a subsequent proceeding.

12. Bandwidth.com will, through interconnection with other carriers or resale of other carriers' services, provide access to 911 and enhanced 911 emergency services and provide

directory assistance and operator assisted calling currently provided by incumbent local exchange carriers.

13. Bandwidth.com will provide comprehensive customer service to its customers. Customers may report complaints to the customer service department. Customer service will be available to answer customer service inquiries in connection with new service, repair or billing. Furthermore, customer service is prepared to respond to a broad range of service matters, including inquiries regarding: (1) the types of services offered by Bandwidth.com and the rates associated with such services; (2) monthly billing statements; (3) problems or concerns pertaining to a customer's current service; and (4) general matters.

14. Bandwidth.com representatives are available twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. Customers may contact Bandwidth.com in writing at Bandwidth.com's headquarters located at 4001 Weston Parkway, Suite 100, Cary, NC 27513, or by calling a toll-free customer service number to be provided on each invoice for service. Bandwidth.com's toll-free customer service number is (800) 808-5150.

15. While Bandwidth.com will offer traditional voice services to customers utilizing the public switched network, Bandwidth.com will also offer services using Internet Protocol to provide voice and data applications that interact seamlessly with the traditional public switched network. Bandwidth.com seeks classification of these services and itself as competitive.

16. Bandwidth.com will continuously monitor and maintain a high level of control over its network on a 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week basis. Bandwidth.com will give consideration to equitable access to all Missourians, regardless of where they might reside or their income, to affordable telecommunications services in Bandwidth.com's proposed service areas in accordance with Section 392.455(5), RSMo.

D. Compliance with Rules and Request for Waiver

17. Bandwidth.com is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards, including, but not limited to, billing, quality of service, and tariff filing and maintenance in a manner consistent with the Commission's requirements for incumbent local exchange carriers with whom Bandwidth.com seeks to compete. Additionally, Bandwidth.com agrees that, pursuant to Section 392.455(3) & (4) RSMo., its service areas shall be no smaller than an exchange and Bandwidth.com will offer basic local telecommunication service. Pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange and interexchange telecommunications companies, Bandwidth.com requests that the following statutes and regulations be waived for Bandwidth.com and its basic local exchange service and interexchange service offerings:

18. The above statutes and regulations have been waived previously for other applicants seeking certification. These rules and statutory provisions are principally designed to apply to non-competitive telecommunications carriers. As a result, it would be inconsistent with the goal and purpose of federal and state statutes to apply these rules and statutes to a competitive company such as Bandwidth.com.

19. Bandwidth.com further requests a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), which requires that a application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange service shall include a proposed tariff with a forty-five day effective date. Bandwidth.com is unable to develop tariffs to fully comply with this rule since Bandwidth.com has not yet executed or received Commission approval of any interconnection and/or resale agreements with ILECs. At such time as Bandwidth.com has determined all of the information necessary to develop its tariffs, Bandwidth.com will promptly file the tariffs bearing no less than a 45 day effective date with the Commission in a manner consistent with the Commission's practice in similar cases. In any circumstance, Applicant will file its proposed basic local exchange telecommunications service tariff no later than 30 days after Commission approval of Applicant's interconnection and/or resale agreement.

20. Bandwidth.com submits, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 392.500 RSMo., as a condition of certification and competitive classification, Bandwidth.com agrees that, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, Bandwidth.com's originating and terminating switched exchange access rates will be no greater than the lowest Commission-approved corresponding access rates in effect for each ILEC within whose service area(s) Bandwidth.com seeks to provide service. Additionally, pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. T0-99-596, Bandwidth.com agrees that if the ILEC in whose service area Bandwidth.com is operating decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, Bandwidth.com shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates within thirty (30) days of the ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap on switched exchange access rates.

21. Bandwidth.com, pursuant to Section 386.570 RSMo, will comply with all applicable Commission rules except those specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to Bandwidth.com's request.

E. Public Interest Considerations

Granting this Application will promote the public interest by increasing competition in the provision of telecommunications services in Missouri. Bandwidth.com will provide customers high quality, cost effective telecommunications services, with an emphasis on customer service. In addition to driving prices closer to costs, thereby ensuring just and reasonable rates, competition also promotes efficiency in the delivery of services and in the development of new services. These benefits work to maximize the public interest by providing continuing incentives for carriers to reduce costs while, simultaneously, promoting the availability of potentially desirable services.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Applicant respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Application for the authority to provide all types of facilities-based and resold local and interexchange telecommunications services.







Management Biographies

David Morken, Co-founder, Chairman and President

In his position as President of Bandwidth.com, Morken presides over the operations, legal, and product areas of the company at its offices in North Carolina.

In 1994, David Morken co-founded the Internet's first online tax filing service, efile.com, which was acquired when he was called to active duty by the United States Marine Corps in 1995. From 1995 to 1999 he served as a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney, Criminal Prosecutor and Company Commander. He left active duty with the Marine Corps in June 1999 to found Bandwidth.com. Mr. Morken is a 1994 graduate of the University of Notre Dame Law School and member of the Virginia Bar Association. He received a B.A. from Oral Roberts University in 1991.

Henry Kaestner, Co-founder, CEO

In his position as Chief Executive Officer of Bandwidth.com, Henry Kaestner presides over the operations of the company and its offices in Cary, North Carolina and Chicago, Illinois.

Previously, Mr. Kaestner was the CEO of Bandwidth International, an international wholesale telecommunications broker based in London, England, a firm that merged with Bandwidth.com in late 2000. 

