ORDER RESCHEDULING ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION

On June 30, 2008, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers filed a stipulation and agreement to resolve all issues in this case. The Commission scheduled an on-the-record presentation for July 29 to allow the Commissioners an opportunity to question the parties about the stipulation and agreement.

On July 16, AmerenUE filed a motion asking that the on-the-record presentation be rescheduled because several of AmerenUE's potential witnesses will be unavailable on the scheduled date. Staff filed a response to AmerenUE's motion on July 22, in which it reported that the parties have agreed that August 18 would be an acceptable date to reschedule the on-the-record presentation. The Commission will reschedule the on-the-record presentation to the time requested by the parties.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The on-the-record presentation currently scheduled for July 29, 2008, is rescheduled for August 18, 2008, beginning at 2:00 p.m. The presentation will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This presentation will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
