ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND FILE A REPORT

After her informal complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") was resolved against her on October 5, 2006, Cheryl L. Fabulae filed a formal complaint against KCPL the following day. On October 10, 2006, the Commission notified KCPL of the complaint and allowed it 30 days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070. Ms. Fabulae amended her formal complaint on October 12, 2006, and also filed a second informal complaint involving similar issues and seeking similar relief, which was consolidated with Case No. EC-2007-0146 by order issued on October 24, 2006.

The Commission would like to have the benefit of an investigation and report by its Staff before it considers this matter.¹

¹ KCPL's answer period has not yet run. However, 4 CSR 240-2.070(10) states that "[t]he commission may order, at any time after the filing of a complaint, an investigation by its staff as to the cause of the complaint."

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall commence an investigation of Cheryl L. Fabulae's formal complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company, as amended on October 12, 2006 and consolidated with her second informal complaint on October 24, 2006.
- 2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report concerning the results of its investigation on or before November 9, 2006.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on November 1, 2006.
