COMES the Complainant and its Motion For Judgment against Ameren Union Electric to this Court as follows:

- Respondent disconnect electric services of Complainant on October 16,
 2006 at for failure to pay service charges from 8831 May Ave.
 St. Louis, MO.
- Respondent just cause for termination of services to Complainant home was that PSC denied Complainant rehearing request on a prior formal complaint before the PSC dated December 2005.
- Plaintiff file a Writ of Review in October 2006 in Circuit Court St. Louis
 County Missouri, which was remanded to Cole County Circuit Court in

- Complainant filed a separate formal complaint before the PSC in January 2007.

- Respondent refuse to restore electric service to 2437 Wieck Dr. while
 Complainant was disputing charges with the Commission.
- Complainant had to remove himself to another address, because he could
 not get electric service to his home which created health and safety issues,
 and a violation of municipal code to occupy the property in October
 2006.
- 10. Respondent Ameren Union Electric attempted to disconnect Complainant's electric services in March 2007 at 211 Coburg Dr. St. Louis, MO, for service charges from another metering point while Complainant was disputing services charges.
- 11. Complainant had paid undisputed service charges in March 2007.
- 12. Complainant file a Motion For Contempt of Court.
- 13. Motion remained unanswered by Respondent.
- Respondent attempted to disconnect Complainant electric service in June
 2007.
- 15. Complainant had paid undisputed service charges for the month of June

- 17. Complainant file a Motion For Contempt of Court.
- 18. Respondent did not reply or answer Motion For Contempt of Court.
- 19. It is the Complainant belief that Respondent violated RSMO. 386.570,
- 20. It is the Complainant belief that Respondent violated 4CSR 240-13.045(5)
- 21. Respondent tactic were to intimidate, and harass the Complainant
- 22. Respondent also display a wanton disrespect for the Complainant due process and Rule of Law.

WHEREFORE the Complainant demands that this Court issue and Order and Judgment against Respondent as follows:

- a. money judgment in the amount of \$2,000 for each (3)violation.
