Yesterday, 8/20/07, it came to my attention that I have been charged a Business Rate from the first day of service at this address to the present. I discovered this when I called your Billing Info Line as a result of receiving a mailing that began with "I wanted to take a moment to thank each of our business customers for...". I inquired as to why I would receive such a mailing, and was told that KCP&L has been charging me the higher business rate for electricity instead of the appropriate residential rate for nearly 30 years. The person I talked with provided me data on the business rate vs. residential, and I discovered that my current bill of \$296 would be approximately \$218 at the correct rate. You might imagine that I was shocked and dismayed to learn that I have wrongfully been so grossly. overcharged for such a long time. 


