ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On January 19, 2010, the parties attended mediation. According to the mediator's report, filed on January 25, the mediation was successful. However the Complainant, Mr. Cowens, has not dismissed this complaint. If the parties have resolved this dispute, then it is likely that Mr. Cowens is no longer concerned with this complaint. Therefore, the Commission will not require Mr. Cowens to file anything to dismiss his complaint. Rather, if this matter has not been resolved, the Commission will afford Mr. Cowens an opportunity to file a letter informing the Commission that he would like to proceed with this complaint.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(2), the Commission may dismiss a complaint if no action has occurred in the case for 90 days. The last action in this case was on January 25, when the mediator filed her report. The Commission will allow Mr. Cowens 90 days from that date to file a letter as described above or this case may be dismissed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than April 25, 2010, Isaac L. Cowens may file a letter as described in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
