## ORDER REGARDING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES AND OTHER FILINGS

Issue Date: April 21, 2011

Effective Date: April 21, 2011

The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting standards for all filings and granting the *Request for Continuance* ("motion"). Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") filed the motion on April 21.<sup>1</sup> In the motion, Ameren seeks an extension of time to file proposed procedural schedules from April 22 to May 4. In support,<sup>2</sup> Ameren cites its counsel's schedule, which requires her to be in trial until April 29. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Request for Continuance* is granted. Proposed procedural schedules are due no later than May 4. Any such schedule shall include:
  - a. deadlines for discovery; and
  - b. conflict dates for an evidentiary hearing between May 17 and June 17.
2. Any motion shall:
  - a. be word-processed or typewritten; and

- b. set forth the relief requested in such motion's title.
