ORDER REGARDING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES AND OTHER FILINGS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting standards for all filings and granting the *Request for Continuance* ("motion"). Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") filed the motion on April 21.¹ In the motion, Ameren seeks an extension of time to file proposed procedural schedules from April 22 to May 4. In support,² Ameren cites its counsel's schedule, which requires her to be in trial until April 29. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Request for Continuance is granted. Proposed procedural schedules are due no later than May 4. Any such schedule shall include:
 - a. deadlines for discovery; and
 - b. conflict dates for an evidentiary hearing between May 17 and June 17.
 - 2. Any motion shall:
 - a. be word-processed or typewritten; and
