On September 26, 2008, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Notice of Start of Prudence Audit indicating that it had started its prudence audit of the fuel adjustment clause established by the Commission for Aquila, Inc. d/b/a KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company in that company's last rate case (Case No. ER-2007-0004).

4. On September 29, 2008 the Commission issued its Order Directing Notice

and Establishing Intervention Date setting an intervention deadline date of October 29, 2008.

5. Dogwood seeks to intervene in this proceeding because the Commission's

decision could affect Dogwood's interests. Dogwood has been an active participant in recent

cases involving KCPL, including Case Nos. EM-2007-0374 and E0-2008-0046. Dogwood

takes no position at this time pending further investigation.

6. Granting Dogwood's Application to Intervene will also be in the public

interest because Dogwood will bring to this proceeding its expertise in the areas being

investigated and its experience as a wholesale electric power provider.
