Finally, the affidavit refers to an attached list of corporate officers, but no list was attached.

The Commission cannot take action on this application until these deficiencies are corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until December 18, 2009, to allow Interface to correct the deficiencies. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
