On February 18, 2014, TELEXFREE, LLC, filed an Application for registration to provide statewide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol Service. On February 19, 2014, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency stating TELEXFREE's application was not complete in that the application filed was not sufficient as an application. This statement was incorrect and should not have been included in the Notice. The only deficiency in the Application is that TELEXFREE's letter is signed by Joseph Isaacs, who is not identified as an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri.

TELEXFREE's filing is deficient and the Commission will not take action on this application until this deficiency is corrected. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
