MOTION TO DISMISS PUBLIC COUNSEL COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) and respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) dismiss the above-styled Complaint filed on May 7, 2002 respecting the Third Year of the Second Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan (EARP II) for Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (Company). The issues raised by Public Counsel regarding allegations that Company had manipulated its Earnings Report in order to reduce the amount of sharing credits for customers with regard to the Second Year of the EARP II have been resolved as a result of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in its Report and Order issued on July 25, 2002 in Case No. EC-2002-1. It is Public Counsel's expectation based upon that Stipulation and Agreement and subsequent Company assurances that \$40 million in credits relating to the Third Sharing Period for EARP II

will be received by customers on utility bills issued this month. Therefore, the abovestyled Complaint case may now be dismissed and the case closed.
