Subject: Deficiency Notice for AmeriVon LLC IXC 2007 Missouri Public Service Commission Annual Report

Mr. Segal,

I spoke with you last week concerning your 2007 annual report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission). I understand from our conversation that you have changed your company's name with the Missouri Secretary of State, however, the Commission requires that you also file a name change in order to be certificated under the new name. I believe Steve Reed from our General Counsel's Office has sent a letter describing the steps necessary to change the certificated name on file with the Commission.

As I stated on the phone, your report was submitted under a name other than its certificated name on file with the Commission. The annual report is to be submitted under the currently certificated name on file. Therefore, your report will need be to resubmitted based on the deficiencies noted below.

As a result of my review I have identified the following item(s) that need(s) to be corrected:

1. The company's name was incorrectly listed. The report must include the current certificated name on each line requesting the company's name. Our records indicate the company's current certificated name is AmeriVon, L.L.C. The name currently listed on the report will need to be changed to reflect this.

A response for this item(s) is required in order to show your report as complete and remove it from deficiency status.

You **must resubmit** the annual report with the appropriate changes to the Data Center as listed below. The resubmission must include the number assigned to your report as listed below in order for it to be properly entered into the system.

Your prompt attention to resolving this matter will be appreciated. The Missouri Public Service Commission's rules within chapter 3 of 4 CSR 240 state that a utility company that receives a notice that deficiencies exist in the information provided in the annual report shall respond to that notice within **20 days** or the utility company is subject to a **penalty of \$100** for each day that it is late in filing its response to the deficiency.
