ORDER APPROVING TARIFF FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH
COMMISSION ORDER AND CLOSING CASE

On July 7, 2005, the Commission granted a variance requested by Union Electric Company, doing business as AmerenUE (Ameren), from both Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.050, relating to metering, and from Ameren's applicable tariff. The facility involved is the Vaughn Elderly Apartments project, located at 1919 O'Fallon Street, St. Louis, Missouri.

In its Order of July 7, 2005, the Commission directed that Ameren "file its amended tariff sheet to include the variance granted herein." Ameren filed its proposed amended tariff sheet in compliance with the Commission's order on July 29, effective August 31.

The Commission's Staff filed its Memorandum and Recommendation on August 22, advising the Commission to approve the proposed sheet. Staff states that the proposed sheet complies with the Commission's order of July 7, 2005.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet filed by Ameren and Staff's Memorandum and Recommendation. The proposed sheet adds the variance

granted in this case to Ameren's tariffs as directed by the Commission in its order of July 7, 2005. Therefore, the Commission will approve the tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed tariff sheet filed by Union Electric Company, doing business as AmerenUE, on July 29, 2005, and assigned Tariff Tracking No. YE-2006-0071, is approved for service rendered on and after August 31, 2005. The specific sheet approved is:

2. That this order shall become effective on August 31, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on September 1, 2005.
