On September 21, 2005, WST, Inc., filed an application requesting that the Commission grant a variance from Kansas City Power & Light Company's tariff to allow it to complete a redevelopment project using a master electric meter. WST indicated that the redevelopment project is nearing completion and requested that the Commission act on its application by October 19. KCPL filed a response on October 3 indicating that it was not taking a position on whether WST should be granted a variance from its tariff. KCPL did, however, indicate that granting the requested variance would raise several problems that it would like the Commission to address. The Commission's Staff filed a response on October 3 questioning the authority of the Commission to grant a variance from KCPL's tariff.

To afford the parties an opportunity to discuss this matter and how the Commission might proceed, the Commission will set this matter for a prehearing conference.
