## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING FILING OF A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 27, 2006, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, ("AmerenUE") filed an application requesting that the Commission grant it a variance from 4 CSR 240-20.050 and Section II.K Non-Standard Service of the Company's Schedule 5 – Schedule of Rates for Electrical Service. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.050 pertains to individual electric metering requirements and a variance from that rule may be granted for good cause shown. (4 CSR 240-20.050(5)).

On August 29, 2006, the Variance Committee filed its verified recommendation and memorandum, recommending that the Commission deny AmerenUE's request. On September 8, 2006, AmerenUE filed its response to the Variance Committee's recommendation and requested a hearing on the variance request. AmerenUE states that it is its desire "to resolve this matter in a timely manner, either through the process of providing additional information to the Variance Committee or through a full hearing on this request."

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure its prompt resolution.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference to be held on September 19, 2006, beginning at 2:00 p.m. The prehearing conference will be held in Room 310 at the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a building that meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 2. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than September 26, 2006.
