On December 26, 2013, Velocity The Greatest Phone Company Ever, Inc. filed a Notification Letter with the Missouri Public Service Commission indicating its intention to offer and provide interconnected voice over internet protocol services in the State of Missouri. The Commission must reject the notification letter filed on December 26, 2013.

The letter filed with the Commission was not sufficient as an application and failed to contain a signed affidavit pursuant to Section 392.500, RSMo. In addition, the filing was not signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(2).

On December 27, 2013, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiencies by January 16, 2014. No response was filed. Thus, the notification letter will be rejected by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The notification letter filed by Velocity The Greatest Phone Company Ever,
 Inc. on December 26, 2013, is rejected.
