ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Commission is ordering the parties to file a response to this order related to the classification of the complaint¹ as unprotected ("public") or protected ("proprietary"). Proprietary is the current classification.

Proprietary information is information concerning trade secrets, as well as confidential or private technical, financial, and business information. [²]

The Commission is considering reclassifying the complaint as public. Before making its ruling, the Commission will consider the response of any party. Any party seeking to maintain protected status for any information shall (A) set forth any information to be protected and the grounds for protecting it, and (B) file the response in two formats: (i) proprietary; and (ii) public, with the information to be protected redacted.
