ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Samantha Blackmon filed a complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company contesting the amount she has been charged for service. The company has filed its Answer. The Staff of the Commission has investigated the complaint and filed a Memorandum and Recommendation advising that the company has not violated any Missouri statute, company tariff provision or Commission rule or order.

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure a resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; the anticipated length of the hearing; and, the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on May 22, 2015, at Fletcher Daniels State Office Building, Room 201 Conference Room, 615 East 13th Street, Kansas City, Missouri beginning at 1:30 p.m. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
