NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On May 20, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO). Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, KCP&L and GMO have 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer. Since this notice is being issued on May 21, the thirty-day period will expire on Saturday June 20. That means their answers are due no later than Monday, June 22, 2015.

As required by Section 536.067(2)(f), RSMo 2000, the Commission informs the parties that the Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission, including provisions relating to discovery, are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.
