

Respondent, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, provide her with dates on which they were available from September 20 through October 20, 2017. The dates were provided by email. Unfortunately, there was no date on which all of the parties were available. Because Public Counsel is not a necessary party to this case, the Regulatory Law Judge had to choose a date when Public Counsel may not be available. Therefore, the hearing will be held in Caruthersville, Missouri on October 4, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. as further set out below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The evidentiary hearing shall be held on October 4, 2017, at the Caruthersville City Hall, 200 West Third Street, Caruthersville, MO 63830 beginning at 1:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the American with Disabilities Act. If you need additional accommodations to participate in this hearing please call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 prior to the hearing.

2. If the Complainant cannot be at the hearing, she must contact the Regulatory Law Judge at 573-751-8518, no later than October 2, 2017, to request a continuance. Failure to appear at the hearing without a continuance being granted may be cause for this case to be dismissed.

3. The Staff of the Public Service Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel may appear and present witnesses via telephone. The Regulatory Law Judge will provide those parties with the conference call information in a separate notice.

4. Any party appearing by telephone shall submit a list of their proposed exhibits and a copy of those exhibits to the Regulatory Law Judge no later than

September 29, 2017. Each party appearing in person must bring the original and two copies of each of their exhibits to the hearing.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.


