MOTION TO INVITE COMMENTS
REGARDING COSTS OF COMPLIANCE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), and for its *Motion to Invite Comments Regarding the Costs of Compliance* respectfully states:

1. Section 536.200.2, RSMo requires the Commission to review the fiscal note that it attached to its adoption of 4 CSR 240-10.085¹ at the end of the first full fiscal year following the implementation of the rule to determine the accuracy of the fiscal impact stated in the fiscal note.

2. As part of that review, it would be useful to gather information from interested stakeholders about whether the estimated costs to comply with the rules set out in the fiscal notes have proved to be accurate.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will by order or notice invite interested stakeholders within a reasonable time to file comments in this docket as to the actual cost of the implementation of the rule.
