INTERCONNECTED VOICE OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL REGISTRATION

On August 24, 2011, TelePacific Managed Services, a California corporation, d/b/a TelePacific Managed Services, Inc. ("the Company") filed an application for registration to offer and provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol. On August 31, 2011, the Company provided the Commission the exchanges in which they wish to provide IVolP service, pursuant to §392.550 RSMo (Cum. Supp. 2010). The exchanges include:

All existing exchange areas in which Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri; Embarq Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Embarq; Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel; CenturyTel of Missouri LLC; Fidelity Telephone Company; and Windstream Missouri, Inc. are authorized to operate in Missouri.

The Commission has reviewed the Application and the First Amended Application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in § 392.550 RSMo (Cum. Supp. 2010).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. TelePacific Managed Services, a California corporation, d/b/a TelePacific Managed Services, Inc. is granted authority to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service in the exchanges set forth in the amended application and restated above.
2. This Order shall become effective on September 23, 2011.
3. This case may be closed on September 24, 2011.
