**MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND
MISSOURI OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL NOTICE OF
REACHING AN AGREEMENT IN PRINCIPLE WITH
KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY AND
REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION OF FILING DEADLINE**

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) and the Missouri Office of Public Counsel (Public Counsel) respectfully submit this notice of an agreement in principle with the Kansas City Power and Light Company in lieu of filing a report or comments pursuant to 4 CSR 240-22.080(6) and ask that the deadline for the filing of such report or comments be suspended.

On or about July 5, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company (Company) filed its Utility Resource Plan or Integrated Resource Plan as required by Rule 4 CSR 240-22.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules governing Integrated Resource Plans, the parties reviewed and discussed the Company's July 5, 2006, IRP filing. According to Commission rules, the non-Company's comments on the July 5, 2006, IRP were due November 2, 2006.

On October 31, 2006, the Department and Public Counsel filed a motion requesting an extension of time to November 15, 2006 to submit comments because of the late receipt of supplemental information from KCPL and the ongoing discussions that the parties hoped would make filing formal comments unnecessary. On November 1, 2006, the Commission issued an order approving this request.

Subsequent to the request for extension of time and the Commission's order granting it, the Department and Public Counsel continued the discussions with the Company and have reached what

they believe is an agreement in principle with the Company on issues related to their July 5, 2006 filing. These issues include items to be addressed in the Company's proposed 23-month filing: demand side resources and programs; integration and risk analysis; and waiver and extension requests.

Subject to agreement on the specific language in the stipulation and agreement that will be submitted to the Commission for its review and approval, the Department and Public Counsel believe that there is an agreement with the Company that adequately address their concerns with the Company's July 5, 2006 resource plan filing. In light of this agreement in principle, the Department and Public Counsel respectfully suggest to the Commission that the filing of comments pursuant to 240-22.080(6) and as stated in the October 31, 2006 Request for Extension of Time is not necessary. Therefore, the Department and Public Counsel request that the extended filing deadline be suspended and the Company has advised that they are not opposed to this request. The Department and Public Counsel will file the Stipulation and Agreement on or before December 19,

2006, or, if the Stipulation and Agreement is not ready to file, then these parties will file a status report on the final draft completion and the anticipated target date of filing.

WHEREFORE, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and Public Counsel respectfully submit this notice of a settlement in principle and request that the deadline for filing reports or comments pursuant to 22.080(6) be suspended.
