- 1. UFM filed its Position Statement of United for Missouri, Inc. on May 11, 2015.
- 2. On July 8, 2015, in response to a *Motion for Leave to File Testimony in Support of Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* filed by the Staff of the Commission, the Commission issued an *Order Directing Filing*, requiring all parties to file their position statements no later than July 16, 2015.
- 3. UFM's position has not changed regarding the issues it addressed in its prior *Position Statement*. UFM will not reiterate herein its position, but will confirm its prior *Position Statement*, except that it will highlight paragraph 27 of the *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* to which it is a party:
  - 27. UFM signs this agreement to the extent that this energy efficiency portfolio is more cost effective than adding additional generation. UFM reserves the option not to

support (although it will not oppose) the AAO in paragraph 13 or participate in the collaboration discussed in paragraph 15, although it does not object to the inclusion of the language for either paragraph in this agreement.
