On September 28, 2005, The Empire Electric Company filed, with the Missouri Public Service Commission, an application to join the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. Empire requests that the Commission issue an order that, among other things: (a) authorizes Empire to transfer functional control of certain transmission facilities to the SPP; (b) acknowledges that the Commission will include in Empire's Commission jurisdictional rates all Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) – approved costs and fees under the SPP Regional Transmission Organization tariff assessed against and paid by Empire, and the prudently incurred costs of participating in the SPP.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to each county in the company's service area. Additionally, the Commission's Public Information Office shall send notice of this order to the publisher of each newspaper located in the counties in which the company provides service, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current *Official Manual of the* *State of Missouri,* and to members of the General Assembly representing the company's service area.

Proper parties wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Copies of the application to intervene must be sent to the parties listed below.
