ORDER FINDING GOOD CAUSE TO EXTEND DEADLINE

On April 12, 2021, the Commission granted an extension of time to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, to file an answer to Mr. Harter's complaint. On May 5, 2021, the Commission granted an extension of time to the Commission's Staff to file a report about Mr. Harter's Complaint. In both instances, the requesting parties indicated that extensions were necessary to allow time to resolve Mr. Harter's complaint.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(G) requires the Regulatory Judge to issue a recommended report and order within 100 days of the filing of a complaint unless good cause is found to extend that time. The 100-day deadline to issue a recommended report and order in this case is June 19, 2021. Because multiple deadline extensions were granted without objection, the Commission finds good cause exists to extend the time to issue a recommended report and order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The requirement to issue a recommended report and order within 100 days of the filing of this complaint is extended.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
