**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING STATING WHEN IT
WILL FILE A RECOMMENDATION IN THIS CASE**

On April 29, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Company”) filed an application seeking authority from the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to issue and sell up to \$150,000,000 aggregate principal amount of additional long-term indebtedness. The Commission will need a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the Company’s application. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation in this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than May 12, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
