ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 14, 2008, the Commission issued an Order Approving Tariff to Establish Rate Schedules for Fuel Adjustment Clause. In that Order, the Commission allowed KCPL Greater Missouri Operations Company (f/k/a Aquila, Inc.) to recover an undercollection of fuel and purchased power for the period of June 1, 2007 through November 30, 2007. The Western District Court of Appeals issued an opinion on February 29, 2008, that the Commission's order approving recovery of those costs incurred prior to the effective date of an appropriate tariff implementing those costs was unlawful. On July 19, 2010, the Cole County Circuit Court issued its mandate in Case No. 08AC-CC00248 which "vacates the PSC's Order and remands for further proceedings"

AG Processing, Inc., and the Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association filed a Motion on August 2, 2010, requesting that the Commission immediately set this matter for a prehearing conference. The Commission agrees this is appropriate and will set the matter for a prehearing conference as set out below. The parties shall appear at the conference prepared to discuss any further procedural schedule that is necessary in this matter and any settlement possibilities.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference is set in this matter to begin at 10:00 a.m. on August 10, 2010, in the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Room 305, Jefferson City, Missouri.
2. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
