On November 12, 2008, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for authority to transfer functional control of certain transmission assets to the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. The company states that because this transaction will involve no transfer of title, there will be no tax impact on the revenues of the counties in which KCP&L GMO serves.

In accordance with Section 393.190.1 RSMo 2000, the Commission directs its Data Center to send a copy of this notice to the county clerk of each county located within KCP&L GMO's service territory.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this notice to the clerks of the counties described in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
