On March 5, 2009, Nancy and Ron Gilkey asked the Commission to allow them to change their electrical supplier from the City of Rich Hill, Missouri to Osage Valley Electric Cooperative. The application included unverified statements from the City of Rich Hill and from Osage Valley Electric Cooperative that claim that the suppliers consent to the change.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(M) requires all applications to the Commission to be subscribed and verified by affidavit, either by the applicant, or by the attorney for the applicant. Also, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.140(1)(H) requires that applicants for change of electrical suppliers must include verified consent of the electrical suppliers in the event the suppliers consent.

The Commission will order the applicants to supplement their application with the verified information, as listed above. The Commission will also order its Staff to file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a Status Report regarding when it plans to file its Recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Nancy and Ron Gilkey shall supplement their application as ordered above no later than March 30, 2009.
2. The Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a Status Report informing the Commission when it plans to file its Recommendation, no later than April 8, 2009.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
